Participation Classes

All Participation classes will be run under FEI Rules 11th edition 2014, updates effective 1st January 2015, in association with EA National Carriage Driving Committee August 2015 Rules. The only exceptions are:

- Horses/ponies do not need to be registered with the EA
- Drivers and grooms must be members of HDT Club NSW Inc. OR EA

General Information

Arrival Time

AELEC is a gated venue. Competitors will be given gate code on payment of stabling and camping fees. Estimated arrival time for competitors and horses is to be stated on entry form. Stables will be open from Tuesday 12 noon before the event.

Horse Inspections and Registration

- **Horse Examination** (health and horse identification): on arrival at venue
- **First Horse Inspection** (trot up): Friday, 4.30pm, location confirmed in Competitor pack
- **Second Horse Inspection**: At compulsory rest, at the end of Competition A
- **Second Horse Examination**: Thirty minutes after the completion of Competition B
(only for Participation Classes).

All horses and ponies must be presented in a bridle fitted with a bit & number attached. Handlers and horse/ponies must be neatly attired.

Stabling

Stabling is available at \$24 per stable per night (*Minimum 2 nights*), plus a \$40 cleaning fee (*refundable if stables are left clean*). There is clean shavings in each stable upon arrival. Book stables with AELEC on (02) 67675658. Carriages maybe left undercover in the cattle yards enclosure. See website for further information www.aelec.com.au

Electric Fencing and Portable Yards

Electric fencing is **NOT** permitted on AELEC. Portable yards are NOT permitted in the powered camping area. However they are permitted in the non-powered camping area with prior approval from AELEC (*Conditions Apply*).

Camping

Powered sites and non-powered sites are available at \$24 per night. Camping, Showers, Toilets, Laundry etc. Book camping with AELEC on (02) 67675658. See website for further information www.aelec.com.au

NOTE* Bookings for Stables and Camping must be booked prior to 13th September, with any booking past this date non guaranteed. Limited spaces are due to Showjumping bookings opening from the 14th September.

Catering

A two-course dinner will be available on Saturday night on the Concourse floor of the Main Arena. Prices and times are to be confirmed. An all day Canteen is available in the Main Indoor Arena Concourse from Thursday to Sunday. Restaurants, McDonalds and Service Stations located nearby.

Dogs

Dogs **MUST** be on leads at all times and all dog waste, **MUST** be collected by owner.

Membership/Insurance (Drivers and Grooms)

Participation Classes must be:

- A driving member of the EA (please supply a copy of your current EA membership card); **OR**
- A driving member of Horse Driving Trials (HDT) Club NSW; **OR**
- A driving member of an EA affiliated Club (please supply a copy of your current EA affiliated club membership card)
- An event driving member of HDT NSW (7th-11th October only) joining fee of \$30.00
- All grooms to be either an EA member **OR** a member of the HDT Club NSW **OR** an EA Interclub member **OR** an event member of HDT NSW (7th-11th October only) joining fee of \$30.00

FEI Classes must be:

- Members of EA/FEI and all horses/ponies to be registered with EA/FEI, with an EA and FEI Papers
- All grooms are to be an EA member **OR** a member of the HDT Club NSW **OR** an EA Interclub member

Children, Junior & Youth Drivers

Junior Drivers for Participation Classes must be 14 years and under 18 years.

Children, Junior and Youth Drivers for FEI Classes must be 12 years to 21 years.

Children, Junior and Youth Drivers must carry a competent adult (EA or HDT Insured) groom for the duration of the competition.

FEI Children, Junior and Youth classes please refer to www.equestrian.org.au/driving and go to FEI driving rules Article 928 – 3.1 (Dress, Safety & Whip)

Participation Junior Classes please refer to www.equestrian.org.au/driving and go to EA Driving Rules regarding dress and safety.

Swabbing

The swabbing of any competition horse/s may take place on the grounds in a designated Veterinary area. Competitors are required to comply with FEI Veterinary Rules and Regulation in regards to swabbing.

Stallions

Please refer to EA Stallion Regulations

Back Protectors

Back Protectors are compulsory for all FEI classes in Competition B (Marathon) and recommended for all EA classes.

Helmets

Helmets are compulsory in Competition B (Marathon). Current safety standard AS NZS 3838
