



Since my time in Australia (August 2009 onwards) I have been intricately involved in the equine sports horse field as I am a veterinarian with a focus on sports horse performance and rehabilitation. I work closely with a number of top eventing, show jumping and dressage riders, as well as a number of Thoroughbred racing trainers in Randwick. I regularly attend dressage and eventing competitions as the on duty vet and understand the challenges riders face to keep their horses in peak condition, as well as the issues surrounding keeping large groups of horses travelling from different areas healthy and safe. In early 2009 I completed a 5 year specialist training in Veterinary Sports Medicine and Rehabilitation which is the highest level of qualification that can be achieved in this field.
