## EvNSW & INTERSCHOOLS EVENTING CLINIC at Sydney International Equestrian Centre



## Tuesday 11th July to Thursday 13th July 8am – 4.30pm daily

This is the third of Eventing NSW's three-day development clinics for 2017. Riders of <u>all ages and</u> <u>abilities</u> who compete at any level from Newcomers to 1-star are encouraged to attend. Entries through Nominate.

Concentrating mainly on cross country riding with groups restricted where possible to FOUR riders of similar ages and ability, there will also be:

- Horsemanship (options include eventing rules, show jump course design, nutrition and feeding)
- Balance practice on mechanical horse with fall training
- Riding to time, course walks
- Individual dressage test practice with lesson
- Show jumping lesson

Our coaches all have years of experience training riders to FEI levels, have ridden to 3-star, and are prepared to mentor at events in NSW.

They include Prue & Craig Barrett, Carlene Barton, Shaun Dillon, Sandy Lucas, Sam Lyle, Jenny Irvine-Brown, Sharmayne Spencer with dressage from Carolyn James and Larissa Chadwick.

The clinic runs over three days with three package options:

- Full clinic, arriving daily:: <u>\$450 per horse first rider</u>, +\$350 for second horse (scheduled over the clinic), \$400 for second rider in family.
- 2. Full clinic, package camping on site with one horse: <u>\$480 per horse first rider</u>, \$380 for second horse (as above), \$430 for second family rider and horse, with stable included.
- 3. Full clinic, package for family using cabin 2 nights with one horse: <u>\$510 per horse first rider</u>, +\$380 for second horse (as before), \$430 for second rider and horse, with stable included.

You may bring your own stable bedding or purchase this at a cost of \$15/bale.

- Families travelling over 300k may have a third night free.
- Camping is for one vehicle regardless of location.
- Cabins have heaters, two single beds. Bring own bedding.
- Gas barbecues, fridge and gas jets available at Mess Hall.

## Bursaries:

Five bursaries are being offered to riders who have evented with EvNSW but whose financial situation means a rider cannot otherwise attend the clinic.
