Conditions of Entry:

1. We are an **EFA affiliated School** and the competition will be run under EFA rules.
2. Horses are not to compete below their EFA grading points.
3. **Entry form and Disclaimer must be signed by parent or entry cannot be accepted.**
4. One rider per horse – only the competitor to be mounted on the horse on grounds. A rider may compete more than one horse but a limit of 2 horses per dressage class
5. Callers are permitted
6. Helmet – Australian Standard Safety Helmet
7. Uniform – Jodhpurs, Riding Boots, School Shirt, Tie (+/- jumper)
8. **NO DOGS ALLOWED ON GROUNDS DURING THIS COMPETITION**
9. **If rider not an EFA member your School Principal's signature is required + a copy of Certificate of Currency for a student's Public Liability cover.**
10. You are required to register at the office before commencing the competition.
11. A gear check is required before each class.
12. Open to Years 3 – 12 students
