A lot of work was made about rider weight size – high level guideline was about 20%. This could be discussed during the Zoom. Some countries have started to implement this as a rule.

## 2.3 Coach of the month / Coaches' awards

- CoM: We now know when we are due: March and September, and we know what we are looking for, thanks to Ben's presentation (Criteria...)
   A "Did you know" on FB (you can nominate COM...) would be great
- **COTY**: The choices we made this year are great as the Coaches awarded have contributed hugely to the Community. Now usually, the way it happens is lots of emails arrive around Nov/Dec, we just need to improve how we do it moving forward. We have 10 months now to put something together.
  - Highlight what we **encourage** and what we **reward, our criteria**, which can align with the Strategic Plan. (X discipline, Level, achievement, ...)
  - People need to understand that it is achievable (and not need to be a L2 or L3 level)
  - Helene to send a draft for documentation

## 2.4 Coach Development survey

- Mentorship was raised a lot which is great (especially people wanting to do L2)
- Advice to young coaches: Keep calm don't be afraid to ask questions / make mistakes / keep open mind.
- Summarise issues for the committee: issues with Legal, insurance. Names to keep in mind for COM.
- Publishing these results could be helpful to other coaches, but we have 45 answers so far
- Website issue: it has been raised a lot. But although it has been pushed by other states and at National level, it is not a priority yet for EA. The cost of it is significant. People struggle to find the information they need, and then lose interest in becoming coaches... The Learning management system is the priority and hopefully will help.
- Do another push to get results after the Zoom, and then publish to coaches (Fb/Email)

## 2.5 Coach Development Day

- Last event done a while in Tamworth. Sally will see with National what we can do. Sharmayne would be happy to help if required. We need to confirm where we do it, as Coaches are not all from this area.
- CE and SSTA update, and accreditation will need to happen, the last one was online. A couple
  of states did their own thing. Online is great for more people to attend, although last live
  session really created interactions. Face to face must happen at some point especially when
  you get to a new level.
- Hawkesbury dressage Festival: The Coach Development Day will be on Tuesday 20 June, similarly to last year
