2.1 Chairs Report

Jim has already put forward an idea focussing on cross training for jumping/dressage riders. Coaches of course to be accredited.

Some classroom presentations too.

Sharmayne/Fiona raise that there could be something about L1 and Intro Coaches, (what CE are expected to see at that standard). Agreed by Rachael who adds that for lower levels coaches: focus on terminology that beginners can understand (who have not read the "textbook") – terminology is obviously different for a masterclass. This would be very valuable for 80% of the audience.

A survey to the coaches would be helpful

2.3 Level 3 Coaching Course

This will be starting in August. Cost and format will be confirmed next week. The original course was 5 camps. This one would probably be 2 camps and 3 or 4 sessions online.

Fiona raises that the EOI document talks about completing a 4* event, 55% dressage, clear XC, 4 penalty SJ => These metrics do not seem relevant to anything else.

Sally mentions that the requirements were reviewed with a separate group who reviewed the L3 Course. This can be raised in the EOI for a possible Zoom presentation.

(Lots of coaches just want the signatures, courses are not so popular anymore).

It seems anecdotally to be the case where more and more student coaches are wanting to bypass most training and just head to assessment and whether we need to slowly address this as a coaching committee and community.
