#### 2.6 Coaching NSW Awards at the ENSW Awards Night

- Megan has sent through her thought to the committee
- Committee need to develop criteria etc
- Committee need to name these awards
- Bruce needs this information in four weeks' time so that he can take it to the board

Action: Develop a formal process, with criteria, weighting and scoring, to select the Coaching NSW Awards for Excellence to be presented at the 2021 ENSW Awards Night (All by 1 May)

#### 2.7 Coaching NSW Survey

#### 2.8 EWA Commit to Coaching Program

#### 2.11 National Committee Update

- Looking at the national safety program and how we want it incorporated into our syllabus
- Syllabus review underway

- EA to put out communique's regarding their meeting
- Level III syllabus has been distributed and reviewed
- There are a few people interested in doing their Level II at the moment, existing workbooks are currently submitted.
- Entry requirements are not being reviewed at this point in time.

- EA trying to deliver a core component that every coach is required to update on
- Trying to run events that all states can participate in and to deliver consistency in presentation.

Syllabus working groups

- Align sports coaching package with vocational education and training.
- Improve and develop assessment tools to comply with current vocational education standards.
- States have agreed to only use EA accredited coaches and are getting in touch with coaches that don't comply to rectify the situation.

#### 2.12 Coach Merchandise

- Agreed to go with EA branding with the removal of Sport Australian logo.
- Currently looking at getting coach merchandise, taken from Megan's tender.
- Link to go out to coaches to order merchandise personally
- Megan is speaking to a supplier

Action: Megan to speak to a supplier in regards to the merchandise (Megan 19 May)
