• Looking at having three categories and the criteria and weighing is as follows

The Covid Coach

- 1) Resilience 10%
- 2) Effectiveness 15%
- 3) Supporting their students through difficult times 25%
- 4) Demonstrates innovation in coaching 50%

To be named

- 1) Coaching at grass roots level 10%
- 2) Coaching at least 10hrs per week 10%
- 3) Good communication skills 15%
- 4) Potential to go further 15%
- 5) Upholds coaching code of conduct and ethics, good role model 25%
- 6) Progress through the coaching levels/looking at improving knowledge and undertaking further education 25%

High Performance Coach

- 1) Teaches in current level of accreditation and looking for upgrade 10%
- 2) Coaches a minimum of 20hrs a week 10%
- 3) Good communication skills 15%
- 4) Upholds code of conduct and ethics and a good ambassador for the sport 15%
- 5) Student competition results and achievements 25%
- 6) Demonstrates a good depth of knowledge 25%
