It is important to note that the role of the Riders Representative does not prevent any competitor from approaching officials or the Organising Committee directly with a concern. The appointed Rider Representative contact details will be posted with the draw and on the noticeboard at the event.

Key Responsibilities:

- To act as a focal point for riders to ask about any aspect of the competition and to communicate those concerns in a timely manner to officials and the Organising Committee.
- To make sure that any changes to the competition are advised to riders in a timely manner.
- To be a sounding board for officials and participate in decision making where required.
- To be available from 7am to 6pm each day of competition.

Selection Criteria for Organising Committees

Discipline knowledge, approachability, empathy for riders and experience in junior competitions are the key criteria.
