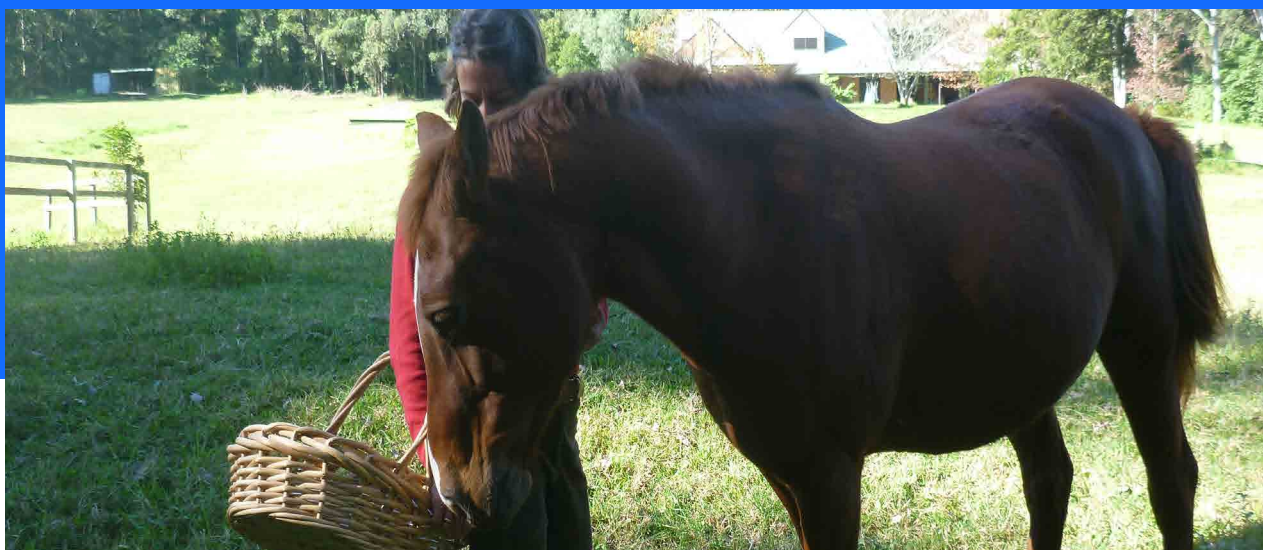


Equiculture - Managing horses on small properties
